Screen specially designed for secondary swallowing reeducation involving reflex action.

#### ACTIONS

The presence of the screen prevents the tongue from extending between the lips, so there is no longer the lip-tongue contact that triggers primary (dysfunctional) swallowing.


Ventilators placed in the lip extensions make it impossible to achieve a watertight seal with the lips.

To swallow, the child has to clench his teeth and place his tongue against the roof of his mouth. In this way, proper secondary swallowing is achieved.

This swallowing process takes place **SUBCONSCIOUSLY**. Learning occurs **SPONTANEOUSLY**.

## **Plain screens**

#### ACTIONS

The screen exerts pressure on the upper incisors when there is an anteroposterior mismatch between the teeth, and reduces the cheek contractions which cause narrow palates.

Breathing should be exclusively through the nose. The screen enables the child to breathe in this way, and thus the maxillary and mandibular jaws develop harmoniously.

Teeth are clenched during swallowing. Placing the screen between the lips and teeth prevents the lip-tongue contact that causes anterior open bites.


The screen is a substitute for finger sucking or a pacifier. The screen can eliminate this harmful habit and restore a healthy functional environment for the harmonious growth of jaws and teeth.



## Screens with bumper

Actions identical to those of the single screen Action specific to the screen with bumper

Orthodontic screen with bumper (EOB) is recommended in cases of dental mismatch, when the lower jaw is receding. The bumper causes propulsion of the jaw and directing the tongue toward the palatine papillae to achieve secondary swallowing.

## Class I mouthguard

**In children:** correction of functional and occlusive disorders in a pre-orthodontic context.

In adults: treatment of snoring. Relaxation of muscles and joints.

#### ACTIONS

The Class I mouthguard helps to correct malfunctions of the tongue such as anterior lingual impulse (sucking the tongue) and swallowing.

The bilateral blocks (Innova Pharma patent) are used to place **the tongue in a high position**.

The vestibular shield corrects mouth breathing into breathing through the nose.

**Lip bumper extensions** neutralize the muscle contractions from the lip-chin region and promote jaw growth.

The shape of the **mandibular arch** is circumscribed within the perimeter of the maxillary arch to facilitate **the engagement of the lateral segments.** 

The mandible remains positioned in Class I.

## Square mouthguard

## Class III mouthguard

#### ACTIONS

**Class I mouthguard facilitates correction of lingual** disorders such as anterior lingual drive (tongue suction) and primary swallowing.

The bilateral blocks are used to keep the tongue in a high position.

Lip bumper extensions neutralize muscular contractions in the lip-chin region and promote transverse jaw growth.

The vestibular shield corrects mouth breathing into breathing through the nose.

The incisor overhang is increased to **correct crossed incisor joints**.

The U-shape of the mandibular arch is circumscribed within the perimeter of the maxillary arch to facilitate **the engagement of the lateral segments**.

### Proccluseur

#### ACTIONS

After an interception phase to stabilize the result obtained, wait for the lateral segments to erupt thanks to the occlusive guide strips.

**Contained** after multi-bracket treatments. Indentations from 14 to 24 and from 34 to 44. The rear strips release the molar occlusion for a physiological implementation.

Nasal breathing training

It can help lift an supraclusion.

## Mouthguards with brackets

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#### ACTIONS

The presence of bilateral blocks provides the opportunity to continue combined swallowing and tongue posture reeducation.

#### Promotes breathing through the nose.

**Promotes intermaxillary traction** by placing the dental arches end to end (possible to adapt the aid by cutting it with scissors).

**Protects soft tissue (lips, cheeks)** during the adjustment period with multi-brackets.

**Mouthguard with uni-maxillary brackets:** aids lingual rehabilitation when only the maxillary arch is bracketed.

It makes it possible to associate a dysfunction with an aid, and to choose the size and density of the aid.

## **USER INSTRUCTIONS FOR AIDS**

#### THE DÉGLUTIX

How do you position the Déglutix in the mouth? **see photo on page 2**.

It needs to be worn for 30 minutes during the day. The child should not think about his aid. He should wear it while carrying out another activity that absorbs his concentration: reading, watching TV, playing a video game.

Wearing the aid at night and the trainings are not compulsory.

#### THE SCREEN

The screen is placed anywhere between the teeth and the lips.

#### **SCREEN WITH BUMPER:**

The screen with bumper is positioned with the bumper downwards, behind the jaw.

#### CFP MOUTHGUARD, CLASS I MOUTHGUARD (DUAL DENSITY), CLASS II MOUTHGUARD (DUAL DENSITY), CLASS III MOUTHGUARD (DUAL DENSITY), SQUARE MOUTHGUARD, MOUTHGUARDS WITH BRACKETS WITH BILATERAL BLOCKS (UNI OR BI-MAXILLARY):

The mouthguard is placed in the mouth, with the bilateral blocks at the bottom under the tongue.

The tongue is then placed in its natural position at the top front.

## MOUTHGUARD WITH BRACKETS WITHOUT BILATERAL BLOCKS:

The mouthguard can be placed in either direction.

#### THE PROCCLUSEUR, THE MODULAR PROCCLUSEUR:

Premolar to premolar indentations are planned to allow the development and positioning of the teeth.



When the aid is in the mouth, patients breathe through their nose.

The recommendation is to wear the aid for 2 hours during the day.

Chewing, breathing and swallowing trainings may be carried out.

Wearing the mouthguard at night helps to establish breathing through the nose as a reflex action as well as automatic secondary swallowing.

In the morning the front teeth feel sensitive; this quickly disappears and is evidence that the mouthguard is working on the incisor-canine unit. At first (for about 4 weeks) it's normal for the patient's mouthguard to fall out at night: it's normal, you must persevere as functional reeducation is a long process.


## COMPOSITION OF THE AIDS

All our aids should be cleaned in cold water with a toothbrush and cleanser of your choice (toothpaste, neutral soap...)

1st <sup>line</sup> aids (Déglutix and screens) can be sterilized in an autoclave machine at 134° in the PRION cycle.

The recommendation is to soak the aid for 1 hour a week in mouthwash or any other equivalent solution. Never boil it.

**ATTENTION:** Lack of maintenance of the aid and its box, as well as poor oral hygiene, can lead to inflammatory reactions.


